Board of Trustees: School Playground Update

Thank you everybody for the \$208.20 that we raised towards our playground on our end of term mufti day. This term we will continue our fundraising efforts towards the school playground.

We applied to a number of charitable organisations for funding and we are very excited that money has come through to us from Blue Sky Community Trust (\$5,000), Pub Charity (\$10,000), Lion Foundation (\$15,000) and Trillian Trust (\$20,000). This means that we are hoping to get the playground build underway this term. We are very grateful for these charitable donations because the playground will be a valuable resource for both our school community and local community.

Further fundraising from school from the write-a-thon and koha box at our school production will be added to the upgrade funding.
