## AMETI Eastern Busway

### Latham Avenue and Dillimore Avenue Road Connection

Dear Resident,

We're about to begin work that may impact you. The work is related to the construction of Stage 1 of AMETI Eastern Busway between Panmure and Pakuranga.

### What's happening?

#### Latham Avenue and Dillimore Avenue road connection

This coming Monday 31 August we will commence mobilising to site. As you will be aware the land has been cleared between these two roads to allow for the new road alignment, this joins Latham Avenue and Dillimore Avenue together to form a continuous road. We will identify existing underground services, install new service pipes and then build the new road construction. New footpaths and driveway crossings will also be constructed either side of where Latham Avenue and Dillimore Avenue join. The final stage of this work is to convert Latham Avenue into a cul de sac at the Pakuranga Road end.

## Service Identification and Relocation Work

Over the week commencing Monday 31 August, we identify underground services in the grass berm, footpath and road from no.13 Latham Avenue to within the grassed area located between Latham and Dillimore avenues.

The mapped location of each service will be marked and concrete footpaths will be cut where services are located beneath them. Small excavators, hydro-excavation and hand digging will be used to expose the services safely.

Following this we will dig trenches to lay new services ducts (pipes) and a new stormwater system on either side of a section of Latham Avenue and through the grassed area where the new road connection will be built. This second stage of work is expected to take between two and three weeks. The extent of the work area is pictured on page 1.

## Building the road connection, and laying new footpaths and driveway crossings

The earthworks and concreting stages of creating this new road connection are expected to take around six weeks to complete. We will meet individually with residents who will be directly impacted by footpath and driveway work, following Auckland moving to COVID-19 Alert Level 2 or less.

**As soon as this road connection is open, we will close Latham Avenue at the intersection of Pakuranga Road. These cul de sac and footpath works are programmed to take six weeks.**

## How will you be affected?

- Consented hours of work are **7.30am to 6pm Monday to Saturday** and we have permission to also work on **Sunday**, with crews permitted to arrive/set up and pack up/exit outside of these hours.
- Noise and vibration associated with the work will be within consent limits that have been set as part of the approved designation for the Project. While working within consented noise levels, these works will be quite loud while we saw cut concrete. To minimise disruption, noise barriers will be installed where required.
- All construction work areas will be cordoned off. Please discuss this work with family, in particular, children to ensure their safety.
- Throughout all stages of work, pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained to all residences and also between the two avenues. At times depending upon the work being undertaken, this access may be maintained under traffic management with pedestrian detours as necessary to ensure safety.
